RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the people of Carrizo Community have filed a petition with the Tribal Council requesting approval for a parcel of land across from the Carrizo Housing Project adjacent to where the old sawmill was located; and
- WHEREAS, reason for the petition is that the Carrizo Community has organized a baseball team and they wish to have this parcel of land to be leveled for a baseball field; and
- WHEREAS, Tribal Council member Virgil Hinton has requested Tribal Council assistance on behalf of the Carrizo Community; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the petition should be granted and that the Carrizo Community should also make an application with the Tribal Land Office to insure there is no conflicting claims to the parcel requested and so that the boundaries of said parcel can be surveyed by the Land Office for recordkeeping purposes.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of the Carrizo Community for use of a parcel of land across from the Housing Project adjacent to where the old sawmill is located in Carrizo and further that permission is granted to level the land for use as a baseball field; provided, that the Carrizo Community first file its application with the Tribal Land Office to insure that there are no conflicting claims or prior designated use for said parcel of land.

The foregoing resolution was on May 23, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 448 Stat. 984).
