FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 163 entitled Preservation and Protection of Religious Sites was returned by the Bureau of Indian Affairs without approval action due to the time limitation prescribed by the Tribe's Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council accordingly concludes that said ordinance should be reaffirmed this date.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms enactment of Ordinance Number 163 Preservation and Protection of Religious Sites on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on May 24, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) (h) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
