## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council pursuant to Resolution No. 84-319 approved an application from Lynn and Alverna Cody, tribal members, to operate a fast food business across from the Alchesay High School on land for which they had obtained a proper land assignment; and
- WHEREAS, Lynn and Alverna Cody now advise the Tribal Council that they wish to construct a feed and supply store on said site and request reaffirmation of the resolution allowing them to conduct a business at said location; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees with their request.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms prior Resolution No. 84-319 allowing Lynn and Alverna Cody to operate a business on the land across from the Alchesay High School previously assigned to them for that purpose.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes Lynn and Alverna Cody to operate a feed and supply store at said location.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it directs Lynn and Alverna Cody to consult with the Tribal Engineering Department prior to construction for purposes of ensuring that water and sewer lines, the state right-of-way and other concerns will be considered.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 05</u>, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
