

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney advises the Tribal Council that the Law and Order Committee has reviewed and approved the attached Proposed Amendment to the Criminal Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to add Chapter Five known as the Victims' Rights Act; and

WHEREAS, the Law and Order Committee recommends to the Tribal Council that the Criminal Code be amended to include the Victims' Rights Act; and


WHEREAS, It is the consensus of the Tribal Council that the Criminal Code be amended in accordance with the proposed Chapter Five - Victims' Rights Act attached hereto and by reference made a part of this resolution.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Council Secretary is hereby directed to post the Proposed Victims' Rights Act Ordinance in each district for a minimum of ten (10) days in accordance with the requirements of the Tribal Constitution.

The foregoing resolution was on June 05, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (q) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
