FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION



WHEREAS, Ms. Marilyn Rose Endfield has been chosen as Godparent, and she has accepted the role; and


WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at the Old Fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Matthew & Betty (Lupe) Tortice and Nelson, Jr. & Rosina Lupe, Sponsors, and Marilyn Rose Endfield, Godparent to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the weekend of August 16-18, 1991 at the Old Fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on June 05, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (g) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
