

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, tribal member, Gregory Lon Kane, son of Lloyd Kane, Sr. and Deanna (Jack) Kane, has requested that his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that he may become eligible for enrollment in the Ute Indian Tribe of Fort Duchesne, Utah; and

WHEREAS, the necessary documents of relinquishment of headrights were read and signed by Gregory Lon Kane in the presence of a Notary Public on June 12, 1991, and are attached hereto.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the Tribal Relinquishment Request of Gregory Lon Kane, and his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe is granted relinquished this date.

The foregoing resolution was on June 19, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of five for and one against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 3 of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

FORT DUCHESNE, UTAH
Further, I realize that I will no longer have fishing or hunting privileges on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; no homesite or farmland assignments, or claim to have title to any resources of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, or monies distributed pursuant to Judgment under the Indian Claims Commission Act.
