

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the Governing Body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has, in the past, successfully administered P.L. 93-638 Indian Health Service Contracts; and

WHEREAS, the current contracts meet the statutory provision set forth by the federal government, that a mature contract is a selfdetermination contract that has been continuously operated by a tribal organization for three or more years; and

WHEREAS, there are no significant and material audit exceptions in the annual financial audit of the tribal organization; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to obtain mature contract status for the following contracts:

1. Mental Health Services
2. Emergency Medical Services
3. Community Health Representative Services
4. Tribal Health Authority
5. Health Education Services
6. Residential Alcohol Treatment Services

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests the conversion of IHS Contracts discussed herein from annual contract status to mature contract status.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Health Authority Director is authorized to participate in development of the mature contracts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman and in his absence the Vice-Chairman is hereby authorized to sign all mature contracts and any other documents necessary to carry out the purposes and intent of this resolution.
