

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Alvin & Regina (Caddo) Quay and family have requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of September 20-22, 1991; and
- WHEREAS, Pedro & Carol (Quintero) Johnson have been chosen as Godparents, and they have accepted the role; and
- WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at Upper Cibecue.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Alvin & Regina (Caddo) Quay, Sponsors, and Pedro & Carol (Quintero) Johnson, Godparents to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of September 20-22, 1991 at Upper Cibecue.

The foregoing resolution was on July 03, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (g) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
