

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the existing Tribal mileage reimbursement rate of twenty cents (\$.20) per mile has not been changed since May 1, 1984; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has just recently increased its mileage rate from twenty four cents (\$.24) to twenty five cents (\$.25) per mile, while the Internal Revenue Service is allowing for twenty six cents (\$.26) per mile; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is requested to raise the mileage rate to \$.25 per mile for the use of personal vehicles while conducting official Tribal Business; and

WHEREAS, the increase in the mileage rate is further necessitated by the increasing cost of operating and maintaining a vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with this request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the increase of the mileage reimbursement for use of personal vehicles, while performing official Tribal Business, from the current rate of \$.20 per mile to \$.25 per mile, effective this date.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
