

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Raymond Kane has applied for a tribal loan in the amount of \$1,736.00 from the Revolving Credit Program in order to improve an existing house; and

WHEREAS, the Plan of Operation for Revolving Credit Program states in Part 6, Section j, "...Committee members will not be eligible to receive loans from the Tribe during the time they are members of the Committee, unless their applications are approved by a majority vote of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe..."; and

WHEREAS, the loan application requires Tribal Council approval because Raymond Kane is a member of the Credit Committee for the Revolving Credit Program.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the loan application of Raymond Kane is hereby approved in the amount of \$1,736.00.

The foregoing resolution was on October 02, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
