

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, tribal member Doris Danford from Cibecue requests Tribal Council assistance to level land that has been assigned to her for a homesite; and

WHEREAS, she advises the Council that she has already purchased lumber and that her husband and herself intent to build the house themselves if they can get assistance in leveling the land; and

WHEREAS, the Council concludes that assistance through the office of the Tribal Chairman should be provided Mrs. Danford.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the office of the Tribal Chairman to provide assistance to Mrs. Doris Danford and her husband to level their land in Cibecue for homesite purposes.

The foregoing resolution was on October 02, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
