

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the General Manager of the Sunrise Ski Park advises the Tribal Council that the area comprised of the Sunrise Ski Park has been recently opened to hunting commencing November of this year; and

WHEREAS, the discharge of firearms may cause costly irreparable damage to the chair lift cable system and other Sunrise Ski Park equipment and buildings; and

WHEREAS, most importantly opening up the area for hunting will endanger human life and safety; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that due to the need to protect human life and safety and Sunrise Ski Park property from damage and injury that all hunting should be banned inside the marked boundaries of the Sunrise Ski Park; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager of the Sunrise Ski Park is instructed to post in conspicuous and frequent intervals No Hunting signs along the entire boundary of the Sunrise Ski Park.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the General Manager of the Sunrise Ski Park to cause to be posted No Hunting signs at frequent intervals along the entire boundary of the Sunrise Ski Park.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Council Secretary to delivery a copy of this resolution to the General Manager of the White Mountain Apache Game and Fish Department.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Game and Fish Department to enforce the ban against hunting within the exterior perimeter of the Sunrise Ski Park for the reasons set forth herein.

The foregoing resolution was on October 03, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (f) (h) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
