RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by prior Resolution No. 09-91-234 directed that Proposed Ordinance No. 174, amending the Judicial Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to provide for the position of Tribal Court Administrator, be posted in each district by the Tribal Council Secretary for a minimum of ten (10) days for public comment as required by the Tribal Constitution; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council Secretary advises that the Proposed Ordinance has been posted in accordance with that resolution that no public comments have been received opposing the establishment or adoption of Ordinance No. 174, amending the Judicial Code to provide for the position of Tribal Court Administrator; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finding no legal or other cause not to enact proposed Ordinance No. 174 in the form and content attached hereto.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts Ordinance No. 174, amending the Judicial Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to provide for the position of Tribal Court Administrator, effective this date.

The foregoing resolution was on October 03, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (q) (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
