

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, District II Councilman, Kino Kane, has come before the Tribal Council and requested authorization from the Tribal Council to transfer 80 hours of his accumulated annual leave to his daughter, Kandi Lee, who is presently in Phoenix at Maricopa County Hospital Burn Unit with her young son who was seriously burned; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Kane also requests Ms. Lee's payroll deductions, excluding the house rental and tribal health insurance deductions, be extended to the following pay period so as to allow more funds for Ms. Lee to utilize while in Phoenix; and

WHEREAS, it is also requested that Ms. Lee's job at the KNNB Radio Station be secured until she returns, which should be in approximately two months; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that there is no prohibition in the Tribal Personnel Code or Policies prohibiting the transfer of annual leave from one employee to another.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the transfer of 80 hours of annual leave from Kino Kane to Kandi Lee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes an extension of all Kandi Lee's payroll deductions, excluding house rental and tribal health insurance deductions, until the following pay period.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Ms. Lee's job at the KNNB Radio Station shall be secured for her until her return.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Director of Personnel to prepare the necessary documents to transfer the 80 hours of annual leave from Kino Kane to Kandi Lee.
