

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by Councilman Kino Kane, that Quinten Lee, the son of tribal member Kandi Kane Lee, is in the Maricopa County Hospital Burn Unit being treated for serious burns to his body; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Lee has been providing support, and will continue to provide support for her son during his stay in the hospital, which period should end in approximately four weeks; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that financial assistance is necessary to provide room and board for a period of approximately four weeks to Ms. Lee; and
- WHEREAS, it is estimated that \$340.00 is needed for an apartment, and \$100.00 for meals; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the request for financial assistance to provide room and board for Ms. Lee during her son's stay in the Maricopa County Hospital Burn Unit should be granted.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appropriates the sum of \$440.00 from the Chairman's Public Relations fund for the purpose of assisting Ms. Kandi Lee for her room and board while she is with her son, who is in the Maricopa County Hospital Burn Unit.

The foregoing resolution was on October 03, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
