

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Karnita Pablano and family have requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of October 11-12, 1991; and

WHEREAS, Reagan and Judy Armstrong have been chosen as Godparents, and they have accepted the role; and

WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at the Turkey Creek rodeo grounds in Seven Mile.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Karnita Pablano, Sponsor, and Reagan and Judy Armstrong, Godparents to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of October 11-12, 1991 at the Turkey Creek rodeo grounds in Seven Mile.

The foregoing resolution was on October 03, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (g) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
