


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Daisy Altaha, Director of the Chaghashe Day Care Center has come before the Tribal Council this date and reported that the roof at the Chaghashe Day Care Center is rotting in places and leaks when it rains; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Altaha is requesting Tribal Council assistance to repair or replace the roof; and
- WHEREAS, Chairman Ronnie Lupe recommends that his office attempt to locate federal funding to repair the roof, estimated at \$7,800.00, and the Tribal Council concurs in that suggestion.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Office of the Tribal Chairman to search for federal funding in the amount of \$7,800.00 to repair the Chaghashe Day Care Center roof.

The foregoing resolution was on November 06, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
