## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal members Carol Declay and her daughter, Renee Declay, have come before the Tribal Council with a request for housing pursuant to the HIP housing program; and
- WHEREAS, District III Councilmembers Randall Massey, Jr. and Kino Torino advise the Council that Carol and Renee Declay are both handicapped, presently live in overcrowded conditions, and should be placed on the HIP Priority List, and the Council agrees with the recommendation and the request.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that Carol and Renee Declay be placed on the HIP Priority List for the reasons set forth herein.

The foregoing resolution was on November 06, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
