

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Professor Joseph Ezzo, from the University of Wisconsin and Professor Jeff Reid, from the University of Arizona Archaeology Department, have come before the Tribal Council this date with a request for permission to conduct further studies of 65 individuals previously removed from the Grasshopper archaeological site which are now in the possession of the University of Arizona Museum; and


WHEREAS, Professor Ezzo explains to the Tribal Council that he has requested a minimum of \$4,000.00 from the University of Wisconsin pursuant to a Tribal Council requests for scholarship monies for educational purposes, but that the University and funding sources for the proposed study were unable, in the time allocated, to guarantee payment of the \$4,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Professor Ezzo assures the Tribal Council that Professor Doug Price, Director of Research for the University of Wisconsin, Department of Archaeology will attempt to secure funding in January of 1992 for scholarship purposes, and based thereon, the Tribal Council concludes that permission should be granted to the University of Arizona, the Museum of the University of Arizona, and the University of Wisconsin to conduct teeth enamel studies of 65 individuals previously removed from the Grasshopper ruins and now in the custody of the University of Arizona Museum.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to the University of Wisconsin, University of Arizona, and the Museum of the University of Arizona, to conduct teeth enamel studies of 65 individuals previously removed and presently in the custody of the University of Arizona Museum as explained by Professors Jeff Reid and Joseph Ezzo this date.

The foregoing resolution was on November 06, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (h) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
