- WHEREAS, the Community Crisis Response Team has come before the Tribal Council and made a presentation of services that it renders to the community.
- WHEREAS, the Community Crisis Response Team explains to the Council that they wish to be recognized by the Tribal Council as part of the Interagency Coordinating Committee so that they can be in a position to actively seek federal funding for services and resources; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council commends the Community Crisis Response Team for their outstanding volunteer work in the community and concludes that they should be recognized by the Council as part of the Interagency Coordinating Committee.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby recognizes the Community Crisis
 REsponse Team as part of the Interagency Coordinating
 Committee, and further directs that a copy of this
 resolution be provided to each member of the
 Interagency Coordinating Committee.

The foregoing resolution was on November 07, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
