

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that Mr. Gerald Lupe, whose birthdate is December 14, 1956, has requested enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee has completely reviewed Mr. Lupe's request and supporting documents; and

WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee finds that Mr. Lupe is eligible for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe and possesses the necessary blood quantum of one-half (1/2) White Mountain Apache through his father Mr. Callis Lupe; and

WHEREAS, Gerald Lupe, has been a permanent resident of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, since childhood; and

WHEREAS, Gerald Lupe is willing to and shall provide to the Tribal Council Secretary, proof of his relinquishment of his enrollment with the San Carlos Apache Tribe.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that based on the recommendation of the Enrollment Committee, that the enrollment of Gerald Lupe is hereby granted membership into the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on November 08, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
