## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that present application for housing through the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority and other housing applications do not contain provisions to identify the handicapped or request information as to whether or not anyone in the household is handicapped and will require special access to the home; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that all future housing applications should request information about handicapped individuals that might reside in the home or who are making application to live in a home.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority to draft new applications or to include an addendum thereto which will specifically identify the needs of handicapped person who may be living in the household applied for or whom may be applying for a home themselves.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 19, 1991</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
