


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Harold and Beatrice (Cromwell) Joe, husband and wife, have received monies from the Hopi Navajo Land Relocation Fund to construct a house on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation through a private contractor; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Joe may be required to pay a tribal business tax and construction permit fee for a total of \$2,700.00; and
- WHEREAS, the Joes' are requesting that the Tribal Council waive these fees.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that for this case only and not as precedent but due to the special circumstances attendant thereto, that it hereby waives the 1% business activity tax and the \$2,000.00 construction permit for Harold and Beatrice (Cromwell) Joe.

The foregoing resolution was on December 19, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
