RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member, Phoebe Patterson comes before the Tribal Council to protest the lack of suitable housing on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Patterson is currently living in a rental unit in Cibecue, and she and her husband would like to have a home of their own; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Patterson would like to be placed on the HIP Priority List, in order to receive suitable housing for herself and her family, and further that she remains on the alternate list for the next HUD project currently scheduled for construction next year; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Patterson would like to receive either a HIP or HUD house, whichever will be available and constructed first; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Patterson requests that the Tribal Council assist her in being placed on the HIP Priority List and/or the HUD list so that she may receive a home at the earliest possible time.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mrs. Patterson be placed on the HIP Priority List and/or that she receive a HUD home from the next project, whichever is constructed first.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 08, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
