RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the homes of Ben Hendricks and Paul Declay, Sr. in North Fork do not currently have running water, and Mr. Hendricks has been trucking water to his house for the past several years; and
- WHEREAS, it is a health hazard to not have running water in these homes; and
- WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service can make provisions to provide for the delivery of water to each home on the reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes that the Indian Health Services should provide water to the homes of Ben Hendricks and Paul Declay, Sr., in North Fork
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Indian Health Services is hereby directed to make provisions for running water to be supplied to the homes of Ben Hendricks and Paul Declay, Sr., in North Fork as soon as possible.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 08, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
