RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Kino Torino, Councilmember from District III comes before the Tribal Council to request that certain improvements and maintenance items be performed at the Seven Mile Community Building and the Seven Mile basketball court; and
- WHEREAS, it is proposed that a fence be erected around the Seven Mile basketball court in order to protect the players and to secure the court when not in use; and
- WHEREAS, the Seven Mile Community Building is in need of repairs, specifically, several door knobs need to be replaced due to damage and several light bulbs need to be replaced which have burned out; and
- WHEREAS, eighteen (18) community members have signed a petition approving that these improvements and the necessary maintenance be paid for from the Seven Mile Land Claims fund; and
- HEREAS, the total estimated amount for these improvements and repairs amounts to \$1,627.00 which includes purchase of fencing materials and the labor to construct the fence and purchase of the necessary door knobs and light bulbs; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with the need for the fencing around the Seven Mile basketball court and the door knobs and light bulbs but believes that the cost can be reduced by having the community members and those who use the basketball court frequently construct the fence instead of paying for the labor, but will leave that decision to the community members.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the improvements and repairs requested by the Seven Mile Community shall be financed from the Seven Mile Land Claim fund.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 8, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
