## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, District I Councilmember Judy Dehose, has come before the Tribal Council and advised that in order to improve the Cibecue Commercial Center and services for the community members, it will be necessary to determine the fair market value of all of the commercial spaces that might be available for rent, renovation or subleasing; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Dehose requests that the Tribal Council requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to conduct an appraisal of the Cibecue Commercial Center for the purpose of determining sublease values and in-kind contributions for future developments; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with said request.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs perform an appraisal of the Cibecue Commercial Center in order to determine the fair market value of all spaces for the purpose of determining sublease values, in-kind contribution, and to assist the Tribe in developing the Center as a profitable enterprise.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 09, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
