RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Councilmember Judy Dehose advises the Tribal Council that the Bureau of Indian Affairs has a partial substation for Land Operations in Cibecue; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Judy Dehose recommends to the Tribal Council that full substations be established for BIA Land Operations, Forestry and Roads Department in Cibecue in order to better serve the west side of the reservation, which includes the communities of Cibecue, Carrizo and Cedar Creek; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees with this recommendation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
Tribe that it hereby requests that Superintendent Ben
Nuvamsa of the Fort Apache Agency, establish
substations in the community of Cibecue for Bureau of
Indian Affairs Land Operations, Forestry and Roads, so
as to better serve the west side of the reservation,
including the communities of Cibecue, Carrizo and Cedar
Creek.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 09, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
