RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Councilmember Frank Endfield, Jr., brings to the Tribal Council's attention that there are several tribal members who should be placed on the HIP Priority List due to their particular personal circumstances; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Endfield recommends to the Tribal Council tribal member Wesley Alchesay be placed on the HIP Priority List because he is in great need of shelter, because his present dwelling is very dilapidated and leaks extensively during inclement weather; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Endfield also recommends that tribal member Carlena (Clarkson) Thompson who is divorced and unemployed and who has a handicapped son also be placed on the HIP Priority List; and
- WHEREAS, he further recommends that Myron Ethelbah who is handicapped should also be placed on the list; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised as to details of each tribal member advocated for by Mr. Endfield as to their circumstances which establish a basis for them being placed on the HIP Priority List; and
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that tribal members Wesley Alchesay, Carlena (Clarkson) Thompson and Myron Ethelbah be placed on the HIP Priority List immediately.

The foregoing resolution was on January 09, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (h) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
