- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with the certification presented by the Tribal Election Commission and is of the opinion that the Commission certification should be affirmed and accepted by the Tribal Council.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the certification of election results submitted by the Tribal Election Commission for the Offices of Council Representatives from District I, II, III, and IV are hereby accepted and the attached certification of election results are incorporated into this resolution.
