RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member, Darvin Burnette has come before the Tribal Council this date and has advised the Tribal Council that he did not receive a pay adjustment which the Council had authorized for workers at FATCO in 1990; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Burnette introduced his documentation that if he had not been overlooked for the salary increase, he would have received an additional pay adjustment of \$259.29 representing the salary increase for 29 days; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that the oversight should be cured by FATCO.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs FATCO General Manager to pay Darvin Burnette the sum of \$259.29 representing the salary increase for 29 days which through some oversight Mr. Burnette did not receive.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 12, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
