RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, there is a recognized need for employment on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, there is a recognized need for trained craftworkers in the Construction Technology, Auto Technology, and Nursing fields and an apprenticeship program would fill that need for training local workers; and
- WHEREAS, there is not currently a local apprenticeship program in which to train local workers, and from which to supply employers with trainees; and
- WHEREAS, Apprenticeship Standards have been developed for the White Mountain Apache Tribe, which give guidance and job specifications for an apprenticeship program; and
- WHEREAS, the Apprenticeship Standards need to be approved by the Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training, Employment and Training Administration, U.S. Department of Labor; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe believe it is in the best interest of tribal members to establish a local apprenticeship program to train future employees and seek approval of the proposed Apprenticeship Standards.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that apprenticeship standards are hereby established, and they are to be submitted to the Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training, Employment and Training administration, U.S. Department of Labor for approval.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby grants the Tribal Chairman authority to sign any and all necessary applications and approval documents on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on February 13, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
