- WHEREAS, tribal member Ernestine Beatty, DOB: 09-17-1961, daughter of the late Devee Beatty and Effie Avatchoya Beatty, has requested that her tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that she may become eligible for enrollment in the Hopi Indian Tribe of Oraibi, Arizona; and
- WHEREAS, the necessary documents of relinquishment of headrights were read and signed by Ernestine Beatty, in the presence of a Notary Public on November 25, 1991, and are attached hereto.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the Tribal Relinquishment request of Ernestine Beatty, and her tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe is granted relinquished this date.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 13, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 3 of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.-984).

Further, I realize that I will no longer have fishing or hunting privileges on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; no homesite or farmland assignments, or claim to have title to any resources of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, or monies distributed pursuant to Judgment under the Indian Claims Commission Act.
