RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Councilmember Kino Kane representing the Carrizo Community has requested authorization from the Tribal Council to utilize \$276.75 from the Carrizo Land Claims Fund to pay for 27 meals and 23 ski rental package for Carrizo Community Ski trip; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with said request provided that Councilmember Kino Kane file the required community petition with the Tribal Council Secretary forthwith.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the expenditure of \$276.75 from the Carrizo Land Claims Fund for the purpose of paying for meals and ski rental package provided that Councilmember Kino Kane file appropriate community petitions with the Tribal Council Secretary as soon as possible.

The foregoing resolution was on March 18, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of \underline{SEVEN} for and \underline{ZERO} against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
