## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, the Tribal Council is advised that there is a severe sewer problem at the East Fork Community Building and that the East Fork Community does not have the funds to repair the problem; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is requested to fund repairs to the sewer system, estimated at approximately \$700.00; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council in the interest of protecting the health, safety and welfare of the East Fork Community and persons who utilize the East Fork Community Building, concludes that money should be allocated to repair the sewer problem immediately.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Office of the Tribal Chairman to allocate funds necessary to repair the East Fork Community Building sewer problem presently estimated to be repaired at an approximate cost of \$700.00.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>May 07, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
