## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Regina Declay Baca has advised the Tribal Council that she desires to build a Mexican food restaurant across from the Tribal Liquor Store, and that in preparation for that construction she has changed her residential land assignment to commercial zoning; and
- whereas, the Tribal Engineering Office has advised her to move the fence back 25 feet from Route 73 in order to make room for the ADOT Route 73 Whiteriver Street Improvement Project, which is due to commence construction in FY 93/94; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in her request for permission to build a Mexican food restaurant in the location she has described.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes Regina Declay Baca to construct a Mexican food restaurant across from the Tribal Liquor Store, with the condition that she remove her fence 25 feet back from Route 73 to make room for the Whiteriver Street Improvement Construction Projects, and that she check with the Tribal Engineering Department to ensure that the restaurant will not encroach upon the proposed widened right-of-way for the Street Improvement Project.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 08, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
