## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by the East Fork Mission Nursery employees that the Tribal Social Services Department is no longer using the East Fork Nursery anymore; and
- whereas, employees of the East Fork Nursery have come before the Tribal Council with a request that the Tribal Council investigate why Tribal Social Services is not using the East Fork Nursery for placement of children; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that a committee of Tribal Council members should investigate why the East Fork Nursery is not being utilized by Tribal Social Services for placement of dependent and abused children; and
- WHEREAS, Tribal Council members Raymond Endfield, Johnny Endfield and Kino Torino are recommended to be on the committee.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that a committee comprised of Tribal Council members Raymond Endfield, Johnny Endfield and Kino Torino conduct an investigation as to why Tribal Social Services is not utilizing the East Fork Nursery for placement of dependent and abused children and to report back to the Tribal Council their findings.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the foregoing committee is hereby authorized to interview appropriate staff at Tribal Social Services to determine why the East Fork Nursery is not being utilized for placement of children under the jurisdiction of the Tribal Social Services Department.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 08, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
