## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, by previous resolution, the Tribal Council divided the balance remaining in the General Land Claims amongst all of the tribal communities with the exception of East Fork, which had previously received an allocation from the General Land Claims Fund for the Turkey Creek rodeo grounds; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council is now advised that the East Fork Community has requested that the \$10,000 in General Land Claims Funds allocated to the Seven Mile Community be divided between Seven Mile and East Fork because the Seven Mile community utilizes the Turkey Creek rodeo grounds; and
- whereas, after a thorough discussion in respect to use of the Turkey Creek rodeo grounds and other factors, the Tribal Council concludes that the \$10,000 from the General Land Claims Fund allocated to the Seven Mile Community should be divided equally so that Seven Mile and the East Fork communities each receive \$5,000.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that the \$10,000 from the General Land Claims Fund previously allocated to the Seven Mile Community be divided equally between the Seven Mile and East Fork communities.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Treasurer to carry out this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 08, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>five</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
