## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, Ramon Riley has come before the Tribal Council on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Traditional Dance Group which he has been part of and sponsored for the past twelve years at various cultural events on and off the reservation, throughout the State of Arizona and the United States; and
- whereas, Mr. Riley advises the Council that his group has been requested to perform in Paris, France and on the Island of Corsica, all expenses paid, except for passports and some administrative costs; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Riley requests Tribal Council assistance in funding
  these additional costs; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council, after due consideration of the total amount requested, concludes that a lesser amount should be authorized in the amount of \$322.00.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes \$322.00 in tribal funds to assist Mr. Ramon Riley and the Traditional Dance Group to travel to Paris, France and Corsica.

The foregoing resolution was on May 07, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of five for and one against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
