- WHEREAS, Wesley Bonito, Director of the Tribal Education Department advised the Tribal Council of the resignation of Indian Education Board member Marilyn Endfield, that her resignation was due to her work schedule; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Bonito further advises the Indian Education Board recommends Lorenzo Aday to replace Marilyn Endfield on the Board and such recommendation is accepted by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Lorenzo Aday to the Indian Education Board.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>May 20, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>one</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
