- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants relinquishment of White Mountain Apache tribal membership to Twyla Cheyenne and Williamson Benally as requested by their parents, Wilson and Barbara (Sanchez) Benally.

The foregoing resolution was on May 20, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of <u>five</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III Section 3 of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
