RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Fort Apache Timber Company is in need of some commercial lots for a Lumber Retail Store; and
- WHEREAS, tribal member, Rowena (Cooya) Jones has three (3) commercial lots assigned to her on Resolution No. 85-294; and
- WHEREAS, Fort Apache Timber Company and Rowena Jones has agreed on a fair settlement for improvements of the three lots; and
- WHEREAS, with the settlement Mrs. Jones agrees to release her assignment back to the White Mountain Apache Tribe by notifying the Land Office.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby agrees to reassign the three commercial lots to Fort Apache Timber Company.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby requests that the Tribal Land Office change all records on the three (3) commercial lots in Hondah Homesite area previously assigned to Rowena Jones to now read Fort Apache Timber Company.

The foregoing resolution was on May 20, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
