RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Sunrise General Manager and District IV Councilmember, Raymond Endfield requests that Sunrise Park be given authority and jurisdiction over the Sunrise signs at Hondah and Carrizo Junction in order to maintain and use the signs for advertisement purposes; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe concurs with Raymond Endfield's request that Sunrise Park be given authority and jurisdiction over the signs at Hondah and Carrizo Junction to maintain the signs and use them for advertisement of Sunrise Park Resort.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it approves the transfer of authority and
 jurisdiction over the Sunrise ski signs at Hondah and
 Carrizo Junction, in order for Sunrise Park to be able to
 maintain the signs and use them for advertisement
 purposes for Sunrise Park Resort.

The foregoing resolution was on May 20, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
