RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, the Whiteriver Service Unit of the Indian Health Service has indicated that several buildings, excluding the building to be used for a maintenance shop, located at the old hospital site are surplus to the Indian Health Service; and
- whereas, these IHS surplus buildings with some remodeling could serve as a Youth Recreation Center that would be located in close proximity to the Tribal Park currently being planned at the old hospital site; and
- WHEREAS, the donation of these buildings would be helpful in the HUD Community Development Block Grant application for funding for the Youth Center and Park.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribe requests that the Indian Health Service turn the aforedescribed surplus buildings over to the Tribe for use as a Youth Recreation Center or for a similar community purpose.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 15, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
