- WHEREAS, Navajo County Sheriff, Mr. Gary Butler has come before the Tribal Council this date and has advised the Tribal Council that he is a candidate for re-election as Navajo County Sheriff; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Butler has established an excellent working relationship with the White Mountain Apache Tribe Police Department, has shown respectful consideration for tribal soverignty and has worked well with tribal law enforcement on mutual law enforcement problems; and
- WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the Tribal Council wishes to endorece Mr. Butler's candidacy for re-election as Navajo County Sheriff.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby endorses the re-election of Gary Butler as sheriff for Navajo County.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 01, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (i) (u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
