RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Commercial Center employee Cynthia (Nosie) Armstrong has come before the Tribal Council and advises the Council that she has been working full-time for the Commercial Center for the past three (3) years but that her status remains listed as a part-time employee thereby precluding her from receiving tribal employee benefits or salary increases which other employees are eligible for; and
- WHEREAS, she advises that there are other employees in the same situation as herself and she is requesting Tribal Council direction so that the on problem of being a part-time employee can be resolved: specifically, that she and others similarly situated be processed as regular full-time employees of the Center; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Commercial Center manager should be directed to inquire into the status of part-time employees who have been working full-time such as in the case of Cynthia (Nosie) Armstrong and that the Manager should be directed to resolve her status so that she and similarly situated employees may receive tribal benefits and otherwise advance in their jobs.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Commercial Center Manager to immediately resolve the part-time employee status of Cynthia (Nosie) Armstrong and other similarly situated employees and clarify their status so that they can receive tribal benefits and job advancement.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Commercial Center Manager is requested to report back to the Tribal Chairman's Office of actions taken pursuant to this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 01, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
