## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal EMS technician Dion Nashio has come before the Tribal Council and has advised the Council of the inadequacy of presently used spineboards for injured persons involved in automobile accidents and recreational activities on the reservation, such as sporting events and rodeos; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Nashio explains to the Tribal Council that his department is in urgent need of appropriate spine boards that are translucent so that x-rays may be taken of the victim; and
- WHEREAS, polyurethane spine boards are translucent, washable, sanitary and much safer for patients; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Nashio advises the Tribal Council that there is widespread community support to purchase fourteen spine boards from general land claim monies and that he has located pro-lite spine boards suitable for the foregoing purposes at \$159.00 each and recommends that each community sponsor the purchase of a spine board so that each community would be given credit; and
- WHEREAS, the spineboards would be purchased with general land claims funds for the following tribal communities:

Cibecue, Carrizo, Forestdale, Cedar Creek, Canyon Day, East Fork, Seven Mile, Whiteriver, Diamond Creek, Hon Dah, McNary, Rainbow City, Turkey Creek and Fort Apache.

and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the health and welfare of persons injured in sporting and automobile accidents demands that very best medical care and that the pro-lite translucent spine boards will greatly assist the Tribal EMS to provide the best emergency care for injured persons.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes appropriations from the General Land Claims Fund for the purchase of fourteen (14) pro-lite spine boards for the following communities:

> Cibecue, Carrizo, Forestdale, Cedar Creek, Canyon Day, East Fork, Seven Mile, Whiteriver Diamond Creek, Hon Dah, McNary, Rainbow City, Turkey Creek and Fort Apache.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Tribal Chairman and in his absence, the Vice Chairman, and any other appropriate and necessary tribal official is hereby authorized to sign any and all documents necessary to expedite and carry out the purposes of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on July 01, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
