RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the governing body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to obtain funds for direct services to crime victims of the reservation; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council has been notified of the grant award in the amount of \$18,640.00 of the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA), for the 1992 program year, beginning on July 1, 1992 through June 30, 1993; and
- WHEREAS, the grant award is for the purpose of providing services to victims of physical and sexual abuse.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves and accepts the Arizona Department of Public Safety Grant, DPS Contract No. 92-937.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the grant will be implemented and monitored by the Apache Tribal Guidance Center under the Tribal Health Authority.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 09, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
