## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the BIA is presently constructing a road in Oak Creek within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the present route is too steep in the proximity of the Three Tank area and should be rerouted for safety considerations.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs reroute the Oak Creek road in the proximity of Three Tanks to eliminate a steep, hazardous incline in that area.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 21, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (c) (h) (u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
