## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the General Manager of Sunrise Ski Park presented a funding request to the Bureau of Indian Affairs totaling approximately \$750,000 for improvements and expansion projects at the resort and it was determined at that time that the best approach would be to first re-examine and update the existing planning documents; and
- WHEREAS, the General Manager of Sunrise Ski Park submitted a letter to the Bureau of Indian Affairs requesting \$50,000 of technical assistance funds to re-examine and update the existing planning documents developed for the ski resort; and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has informed the Tribe that \$40,000 is available for the proposed updating of the existing plan for Sunrise and additional funds may become available in the near future.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Planning Office to submit a grant application to the Bureau of Indian Affairs in the amount of \$40,000 to re-examine and update the existing plans for the Sunrise Ski Park Resort.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to consummate the grant agreement.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 06, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
